

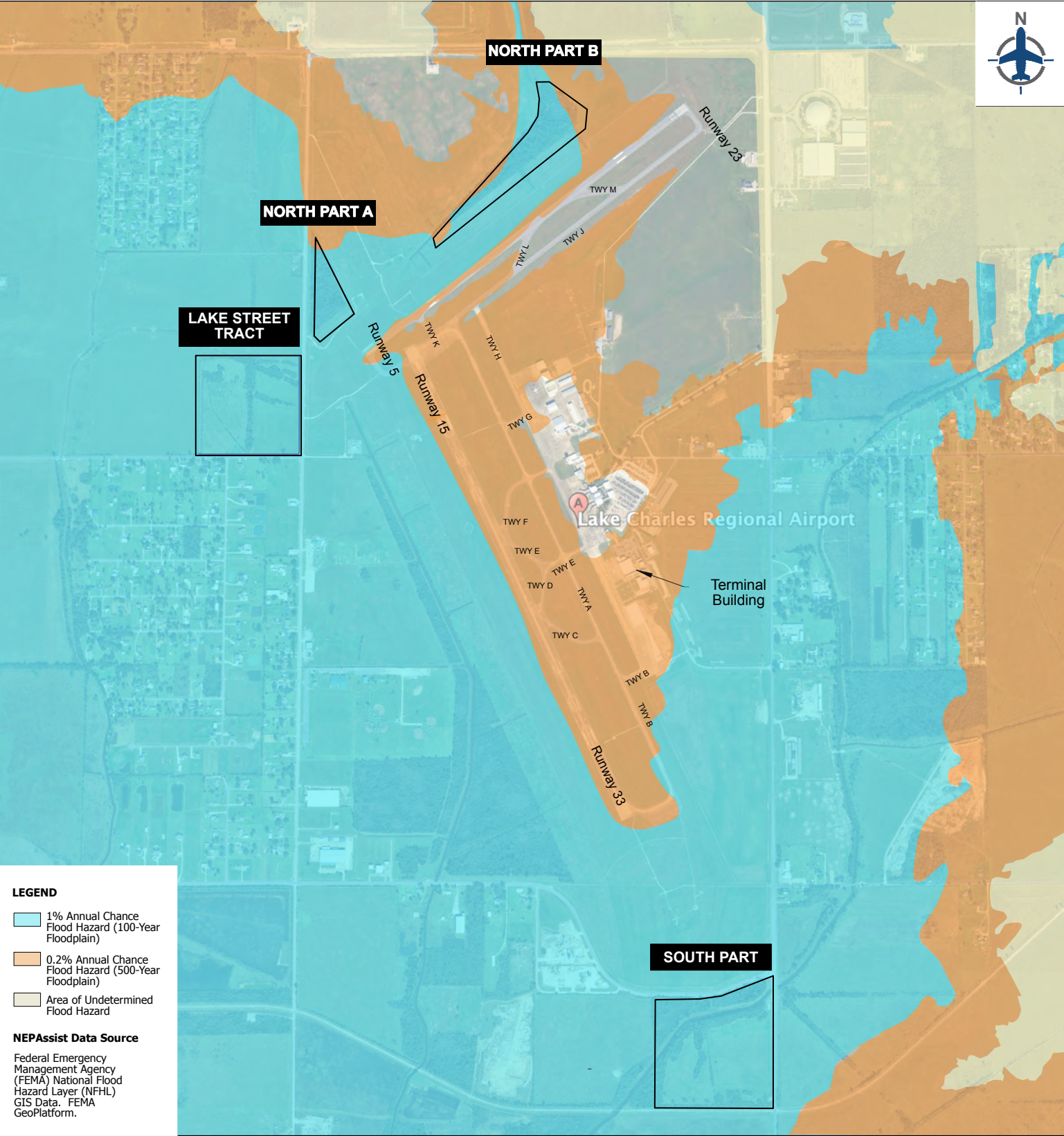
FLOODPLAIN NOTICE

The Lake Charles Regional Airport (LCH) plans to remove trees that lie within areas on airport property. This project is required to improve safety and efficiency of the Airport for the traveling public and to minimize wildlife attractants. This will involve removal of trees in four (4) designated areas that are located within the 100-year floodplain.

The proposed project is located entirely on the Lake Charles Regional Airport in Lake Charles, Louisiana.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried out by FAA Order 1050.1G. Per Executive Order 11988, Floodplain Management, the Airport, and the FAA have determined the proposed project components are located within the 100-year floodplain. The Airport and the FAA are presently identifying and evaluating the potential impacts, if any, on the floodplain. The project's impact on the floodplain is anticipated to be negligible; therefore, would not result in an adverse impact on the floodplain's natural and beneficial floodplain values. The encroachment would not impact existing infrastructure, would not have adverse impacts to the floodplain's natural and beneficial values, would not have a substantial probability of loss of human life, safe airport operations will not be affected, and aircraft services will not be interrupted.

If requested, a Public Meeting to review the project and provide comments will be granted in conjunction with FAA policy and floodplain review.
